Music	Students, staff and visitors	Injury	Low	Injuries could include cuts, grazes, bruises. Musical instruments should be checked thoroughly by the member of staff supervising the student before use. Any faults should be logged in the fault log immediately and the instrument taken out of use. Students should use instruments in a calm manner to avoid the risk of breaking the instrument which could cause an injury. Students should not bring in instruments from home but use the instruments provided at CoRE.	
		Noise	Medium	Students are not permitted to play musical instruments excessively loud. Many students that access CoRE have sound sensitivities, and these must be taken into account before students play the musical instruments to ensure the environment can be accessed by all students. Ear defenders can be offered to students who are noise sensitive. Noise sensitive students may want to access quieter areas of the site when music is being played.	
		Technical failures	Low	Electrical equipment is PAT tested annually. Musical instruments should	

			be checked thoroughly by the member of staff supervising the student before use. Any faults should be logged in the fault log immediately and the instrument taken out of use
