Fencing is regularly checked and maintained by the land manager to ensure any gaps/collapses are fixed as quickly as possible to avoid additional entry/exit points that could be used by students or wider members of the public. Students are only permitted on the road when walking to visit the big pigs, high vis must be worn by staff and pupils.. Students are supervised at all times, and are escorted when in the car park. The gate is to remain shut during operational hours, and only opened to allow staff pre-booked visitors and student transport in when required. Students are not permitted by the river or in the woods unattended (see rivers and ponds and big woods risk assessments for further details)	
		CCTV	Low	To deter trespasses and monitor activity on site, CCTV has been installed to cover the main gate, the

	Main Gate	Low	The gate is to remain shut during operational hours, and only opened to allow staff pre-booked visitors and student transport in when required. Students are not permitted to climb on the main gate. Students are not permitted to open the gate for staff/visitors due to the proximity to the road.	
	Members of the public	Low	Limemead Farm should remain a closed site, with only permitted staff/students and visitors allowed on site by prior arrangement. There are no public footpaths through the land. Members of the public who trespass onto the land, intentionally or unintentionally will be escorted off the premises by the Education Manager, Alasdair Green or the Director, Rachelle Green.
